**“Why are you adopted?” “What does foster care mean?” Could your child use support telling their story or making new friends? Would you like a chance to connect with other caregivers of children who are also trying to support their children’s social development? This 3-week group is for children (ages 7-10) to strengthen their social skills, particularly around their family story. Children and caregivers can learn from others, and develop a social skills toolkit.**

Each week, we will discuss specific topics regarding socializing with peers, building stronger communication skills, and using effective language while having fun! There will also be plenty of time for informal discussion, support, and sharing. Group leaders will also share resources including books, films, and articles.
