If child is in agency custody, the medical care is managed by Hamilton Co. Child Services.

If the caregiver has custody, they can apply online for medical along with the "Child Only Benefits".

## Kinship Permanency Incentive Program:

- Caregivers must have received custody from a court proceeding on or after July 1, 2005
- Caregivers are eligible for a total of 8 payments over a 48 month period.

## Courts must have awarded legal custody or

guardianship of the child to the grandparent, relative or other kinship caregiver, based on the best interest of the child. A Public Children's Services Agency must have been involved and completed the relative approval process including a criminal background check.
